- A Dark Day in Israel: (1 Samuel 4:10-12)
 - "In the day of prosperity be joyful, and in the day of adversity consider: God has made the one as well as the other..." (Ecclesiastes 7:14)
- The Foolishness of Lies: (2 Samuel 1:-10)
 - "A false witness will not go unpunished, and he who breathes out lies will perish" (Proverbs 19:9). "There are six things that the LORD hates, seven that are an abomination to Him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that make haste to run to evil, a false witness who breathes out lies, and one who sows discord among brothers" (Proverbs 6:16-19).
- The Beauty of Grief Honor and Love: (2 Samuel 1:11-12)
 - "Do not rejoice when your enemy falls, and let not your heart be glad when he stumbles, lest the LORD see it and be displeased, and turn away His anger from him" (Proverbs 24:17-18). "Be subject for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether it be to the emperor as supreme, or to governors as sent by Him to punish those who do evil and to praise those who do good. For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people" (1 Peter 2:13-15).
- The Grace of Fearing God: (2 Samuel 1:13-16)
 - "How is it you were not afraid to put out your hand to destroy the LORD's anointed?" (2 Samuel 1:14; cf. 1 Samuel 24:6; 1 Samuel 26:9-11).
 - o "The fear of the LORD is hatred of evil. Pride and arrogance and the way of evil and perverted speech I hate" (Proverbs 8:13). "Be not wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD, and turn away from evil" (Proverbs 3:7). "Since we have these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from every defilement of body and spirit, bringing holiness to completion in the fear of God" (2 Corinthians 7:1; cf. Philippians 2:12-13).
