"The Davidic Covenant" (Part 2) 2 Samuel 7:1-17; Psalm 89:3-4

What is an Unconditional Covenant Biblically? It is God initiated and God determines the details of it and God fulfills it. It is unilateral. Persons are recipients, not contributors; they are not expected to offer elements to the bond; they are called to accept it as offered, to keep it as demanded, and to receive the results that God, by oath, assures will not be withheld.

- What is the Davidic Covenant?
 - o David's name will be made great. (7:9)
 - A home will be provided for Israel. (7:10)
 - Israel will be given undisturbed rest from their enemies. (7:10-11)
 - The line of David will endure. (7:11)
 - A coming Son will establish the Kingdom. (7:12)
 - Solomon will build the Temple. (7:13)
 - Solomon's kingdom (physical) will be established forever. (7:13)
 - o God will be a Father for Solomon and Solomon's sins will not break the covenant. (7:14-15)
 - The throne of David (physical) will be established forever. (7:16)
- How do we know that Jesus is the fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant?
 - The testimony of the angel Gabriel, is that the birth of Christ is the beginning of the fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant (Luke 1:32-33).
 - Luke and Matthew's genealogies argue that Christ is the fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant (Matthew 1:6-16; Luke 3:31).
 - The Early Church taught that Jesus was the fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant (Acts 2:30-36; Acts 13:33-37).
 - Jesus says in the book of Revelation He is the fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant (Revelation 3:7; 22:16).
- How do we know this throne is a physical throne and not a spiritual throne?
 - Jesus taught and the Jews expected a physical throne and a physical kingdom (Matthew 6:10; 19:28-29; Luke 19:11-12; Acts 1:6-7; 3:20-21; 1 Corinthians 6:2; Hebrews 10:12-13; Revelation 1:5; 5:10)
 - The Old Testament also taught that the Davidic Throne is physical (Psalm 2:1-12; Isaiah 9:6-7; 11:1-10; Daniel 7:13-14; Zechariah 9:9-10; 14:9).

So what?

- Our minds should be blown in how God connects human history from beginning to end, namely, Genesis 1:28; Isaiah 9:6-7; 11:1-10; Daniel 7:13-14; Luke 19:11-26; Revelation 20:4-6. Showing His infinite wisdom, power, and love for mankind.
- The Davidic Covenant has eternal significance for us (1 Corinthians 6:2; Revelation 5:10; 2 Timothy 2:12; Revelation 20:4 & 6).
