"What Solomon wants to show us is that the real basis of wisdom is a frank acknowledgement that this world's course is enigmatic (difficult or impossible to understand), that much of what happens is quite inexplicable (unable to be explained) to us, and that many occurrences on this planet will bear no outward sign of a rational, moral God ordering them." (JI Packer)

"In the day of prosperity be joyful, and in the day of adversity consider: **God has made** the one as well as the other, so that **man may not find out** anything that will be after him." (Ecclesiastes 7:14)

"Then I saw all **the work of God**, that man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun. However much man may toil in seeking, **he will not find it out**. Even though a wise man claims to know, **he cannot find out**." (Ecclesiastes 8:17)

"As you do not know the way the spirit comes to the bones in the womb of a woman with child, so **you do not know** the work of **God who makes everything**." (Ecclesiastes 11:5)

  - 1) God is in absolute sovereign control over all things.
  - 2) There are certain things that man cannot know, and that is good for us.
  - 3) Life is full of prosperity and adversity, and that is good for us.
  - 4) God doesn't owe us an explanation.
  - 5) One of Corporate Worship's goals is to recalibrate us to TRUTH and REALITY.

"The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil."

(Ecclesiastes 12:13-14)

- Six more truths we need reminded of in a broken world:
  - 1) The whole duty of man is to fear God and obey God.
  - 2) To fear God is to lovingly submit to Him no matter what.
  - 3) To obey God is to make His Word a priority to know and practice no matter what.
  - 4) God knows and sees everything.
  - 5) You will be judged by God.
  - 6) One of Corporate Worship's goals is to remind me of these truths.
