- The Desires of the Eyes: "If You, then, will worship me, it will all be Yours."
 - The Desires of the Eyes are the temptations of worldly, non-satisfying, non-lasting delights, forsaking true eternal delights!
 - Secular Entertainment; Intellectualism or Worldly Thinking; Counsel of the Ungodly; Participating in what you Covet; "Building Bigger Barns"; and "Black Hole" Desires (Psalm 1:1-2).
 - "The Christian disposition is 'enough for me and abundance for the Work of God'." (John Piper [cf. Acts 20:35])
- The Pride of Life: "Since You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here."
 - **The Pride of Life** is the desire for significance, recognition, importance, status symbols of success, accolades, salaries, vacations, vehicles, homes, and overall impressiveness.
 - What I do is important, essential, valuable, because man's praise says so. Instead God is important, essential, valuable, because God's Word says so.
