"Zealous Christianity: Beware of Self-Righteousness" (Part 2) Matthew 6:1-18

"Love grows in secret, quiet, private behaviors that overflow into the public square in acts of love done for the glory of God. Self-righteousness has the intent of being seen by men, for the praise of men, for the glory of self."

- The differences between the Grace of Christ and the Law of Christ:
 - As time goes, keeping the intensity of passionate love requires far more than law or rule keeping. It requires going beyond the minimum of law keeping and striving for a maximum commitment to showing the worth of the object of your affection. When Christ is pursued from a heart of love, by the means of grace and wisdom, our acts of love go from heavy to light. (cf. Matthew 11:28-30)
- Matthew 6:1-8,16-18:
 - We are told to be *generous*, *to pray*, and *to fast*....but now how often, or how much, from what, or how long?
 - The Warning: "Beware of practicing your righteousness before other people...." (Matthew 6:1)
 - The Command: "Let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works...."
 (Matthew 5:16)
 - The Warning: "Beware of wanting to be seen by men." (Matthew 6:1)
 - The Goal: "They would give glory to God." (Matthew 5:16)
 - Do we want to be *rewarded* by God or do we want to be *rewarded* by men?

Private love shows itself in public love. Private humility shows itself in public humility. Private patience shows itself in public patience. Private self-righteousness shows itself in public self-righteousness.

- <u>Side note:</u> Private, humble pursuit of God always shows itself in forgiveness. If it is not easy to forgive, you are being *self-righteous*. If it is not easy for you to admit sinning, you are being *self-righteous*. (Matthew 6:14-15)
- Marks of Self-Righteousness: Love and Grace killers!
 - Self-Righteousness *loves to* point out the sins of others, but despises having their sins pointed out. (Matthew 23:25-26)
 - Self- Righteousness *loves to* have attention drawn to how committed or religious they are. They
 like to point out their doctrinal disciplines, their practical disciplines, or their accolades. (Matthew
 23:5-7)
 - Self-righteousness does not listen, will not have their mind changed, and cannot be wrong.
 They love being right more than being humble. (Matthew 23:1-4)
 - Self-righteousness *loves* glory, and hates others being recognized. They are jealous and fearful
 of someone replacing them, even Jesus. (Matthew 23:13-15)
 - Self-righteousness is a devotion to caring how you are seen by men, not how you are seen by God (Matthew 23:5).
