"The Generational Sin of *the Love of Money*" (Part 2) 1 Timothy 6:17-19; Luke 12:13-34

"He is no fool **who gives** what he cannot keep **to gain** what he cannot lose." (Jim Elliot)

"The Pharisees, who were *lovers of money*, heard all these things, and *they ridiculed Him*. And He said to them, 'You are those who justify yourselves before men, but *God knows your hearts*. For what is exalted among men is *an abomination* in the sight of God.' " (Luke 16:14-15)

"Sell your possessions, and give to the needy. **Provide yourselves** with moneybags that do not grow old, **with** a **treasure in the heavens** that does not fail, where no thief approaches and no moth destroys." (Luke 12:33)

"Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth....but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven...."

(Matthew 6:19-20)

"They are to do good, **to be rich in good works**, to be generous, and ready to share, thus **storing up treasure for themselves....**" (1 Timothy 6:18-19a)

- Observations from Luke 12:15-34:
 - Covetousness is to be protected against because the love of money destroys people spiritually.
 - o *True life* does not consist of your possessions, but instead being rich towards God.
 - God does not give us our resources primarily for our comfort in this life (relax, eat, drink, be merry). He gives us resources to be used in a way that will make us rich towards God ("build larger barns" in eternity).
 - We are free to give our lives fully to eternal "barn building". We can seek His kingdom because we know He will provide what the world works for.
 - We do not have to worry about *giving to God* or *losing things for God*. It is a possibility to lose our resources for the gospel and to give our resources for the gospel (Hebrews 10:33-34 Public mockery, prison, plundering of property).
 - The love of money is a faith issue...."O you of little faith".
 - Is what we pursue and what we are anxious about the same things the world pursues and is anxious about?
 - Our hearts are shown by our attitudes about giving greatly and being willing to suffer greatly for the gospel.
 - God will always give us what we need to serve Him.
- Observations from 1 Timothy 6:17-19:
 - The more you have the less you want to engage with the suffering around you; spiritually and physically. You want to "fence yourself in".
 - o In Christ, possessions are to be *primarily used for eternity*, not temporal things.
 - Possessions are *most enjoyed* when they are used for eternal gain.
 - Do good, be rich in good works, be generous, be ready to share.
 - Show the world what *true life is*, namely, living for eternity.
