Deuteronomy 6:1-15

“You shall **teach them diligently** to your children, and **shall talk of them** when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.” (Deuteronomy 6:7)

“My son, if you **receive my words** and **treasure up** my commandments with you, making **your ear attentive** to wisdom and **inclining your heart** to understanding....if you **seek it like silver** and **search for it** as for hidden treasures, then **you will understand** the fear of the LORD and **find** the knowledge of God.”
(Proverbs 2:1-5)

“Older women....they are **to teach** what is good, and so **train** the young women....**that the word of God may not be reviled**” (Titus 2:3b-5). “and what you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses **entrust to faithful men**, who will be able to **teach others** also” (2 Timothy 2:2). “Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but **bring them up** in the **discipline and instruction** of the Lord” (Ephesians 6:4).

● **Goals:**

- That we would admit that the American way, instead of the Biblical way of life, is **anti-family** and **anti-Christianity**. That we would repent of any justification of the world’s systems, and that we would commit to live **a Biblical Worldview** way of life, **no matter the cost.**

● **What is a Biblical Family?**

- (Ephesians 5:22-33) A Biblical Family is led by a father who leads, protects, and provides for the family spiritually, physically, and emotionally. He takes initiative in the discipline of his children, what the kids do with their leisure time, family devotions, how money is spent, and the families patterns of life and so on.
- (Ephesians 5:22-33) A Biblical Family has a mother who supports her husband in his leadership by encouraging him, communicating well with him, works at home, and submits to her husband's godly leadership and helps disciple their children.
- (Ephesians 6:1-3) A Biblical Family has children that submit to and obey their parents. They are lovingly disciplined by their parents and the expectation is that they joyfully do what their parents tell them to do. Their parents are relentless in this pursuit so that they train their children **to submit and to obey** all other authority and **ultimately God.**
